One vulnerability in BRAIN2

BIZERBA-SA-2021-0002

July 2021

1 Overview

A vulnerability has been discovered affecting the Bizerba BRAIN2 software with versions 2.40 and lower.

Bizerba rates these vulnerabilities with a CVSS v3.01 Base Score of 6.6 (Medium) and recommends customers apply the recommended workarounds and mitigations.

The vulnerabilities have been discovered during internal product tests.

2 Technical Details

2.1 Bizerba-CVE-2021-0004

- With logging level “Trace Limited, Trace SQL or Trace All” the product stores user and password in the log file when creating a new BRAIN2 user or changing its password.

CVSS Rating

The CVSS v3.0 Base Score is rated at: 6.6 (Medium)

- Change log level to less than “Trace Limited”
- Delete all log files in the folder “C:\ProgramData \Bizerba\BRAIN2\Log\Bizerba.MainService”
